II. NOTICE OF CALLING ATTENTION MOTION

When enquired by Shri Anil Vij, a member of Bhartiya Janta Party with regard to his Calling Attention Motion regarding giving economic package to the industries in Haryana State to compete the Excise Free Zone Industries in the neighbouring States, the Speaker informed that the same was under consideration.

IV. GENERAL DISCUSSION ON BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 2010-11

General discussion on the budget estimates for the year 2010-11 was taken place

Dr. Raghuvir Singh Kadian, a member from the Treasury Benches, spoke for 39 minutes.

Shri Om Parkash Chautala, a member from the Indian National Lok Dal, also spoke for 54 minutes.

Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar, a member from the Bhartiya Janta Party, also spoke for 26 minutes.

V. ADJOURNMENT OF THE SITTING

During discussion on the Budget, when Shri Om Parkash Chautala, a member from Indian National Lok Dal, was speaking on the Budget, there were heated exchange of arguments between the members of the Treasury Benches and Opposition Benches. The Speaker repeatedly asked the members to maintain decorum and not to disrupt the proceedings of the House.

Aggrieved with the grave disorder in the House, the Speaker adjourned the sitting of the House at 12.06 P.M. for half an hour.

The House then adjourned at 12.06 P.M. and re-assembled at 12.36 P.M.

When the House re-assembled, the Speaker requested all the members of the House to speak only on the Budget and not to pass personal remarks against each other so that the proceedings of the House may not be disrupted.

Shri Randeep Singh Surjewala, Parliamentary Affairs Minister and Shri Om Parkash Chautala, a member from the Indian National Lok Dal, showed their regret on behalf of all members of the House for hurting the sentiments of the Speaker and assured the Speaker that they would give their full cooperation during the proceedings of the House.

Prof. Sampat Singh, a member from the Treasury Benches, who had spoken for 15 minutes, was still in possession of the House, when it adjourned at 2.00 P.M.

The Deputy Speaker occupied the Chair from 11.16 A.M. to 11.54 A.M.

The Sabha then adjourned till 10.00 AM on Friday the 12th March, 2010.
