## THE HARYANA APPROPRIATION (NO. 2) BILL, 2025

A

### BILL

to authorize payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Haryana for the services during the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 2026.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Haryana in the Seventy-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Haryana Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2025.

Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Haryana, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 5 of the Schedule appended to this Act, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Two Lakh Fifty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Nine Crore, Ninety-Eight Lakh, Thirty-Seven Thousand, Thirty Rupees only (₹258339,98,37,030) towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the financial year 2025-26, in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.

Issue of ₹258339,98,37,030 out of Consolidated Fund of State of Haryana for Financial year 2025-26.

3. The sums authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Haryana by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 2026.
