 - b) the number of samples that failed the test for being fit for human consumption in rural and urban areas separately;
 - c) whether any water samples taken for bacteriological tests from Lala Sham Super Specially Centre of PGIMS in the year 2011 were found contaminated with potentially deadly bacteria and the report also indicated the presence of coli form of bacteria in dangerously high proportions and the presence of either human or animal faeces; and
 - d) the number of filter beds/media that are lying defunct in water works based on canal water in Haryana?
