At present, no village of Kharkhoda Assembly Constituency has been provided 24 Hrs supply under Mahara Gaon jagmag Gaon Scheme.

NOTE FOR PAD

There are 45 villages in Kharkoda Assembly Constituency. Out of these 45 villages, 01 village namely Sohti on 11 KV Sohti-1 RDS Feeder after completion of work under MGJG Scheme was allowed 24 Hrs supply w.e.f 15.08.2019 in Kharkoda Assembly Constituency. But, due to high line losses and hindrance by villagers in the work of Meter Reading and collection of the bills, the supply was reduced from 24 Hrs to 16 Hours on dated 04.11.2019. Details of Line losses of 23 RDS feeders having 45 villages in Kharkhoda Assembly Constituency are as under:-

Mhara Gaon Jagmag Gaon (MGJG) scheme was launched in the State on 01.07.2015. The aim of the scheme is to provide electricity to the villagers on the urban pattern. Following activities are being carried out in the villages to improve the quality of service to consumers:

- i) Replacement of bare conductor with AB cable.
- ii) Replacement of defective/electro mechanical meters.
- iii) Shifting of meters outside the premises.
- iv) Maintenance of DT's.
- v) Maintenance of LD system
- vi) While replacement/relocation of meter as a onetime measure, the meter would be replaced on the spot without further checking from the M&T Lab.

At present, 24 hours supply is being given on 1048 Nos. 11 KV RDS feeders covering 4463 villages in the State after completion of work under MGJG scheme. 24 Hours supply is being provided to all villages of District namely Ambala, Panchkula, Yamuna Nagar, Kurukshetra, Faridabad, Gurugram, Rewari, Sirsa & Fathebad.
