NOTE FOR THE PAD

AYUSH Department Haryana is providing health care services through one Institute of Indian System of Medicine and Research, Panchkula (IISM&R), 4 Ayurvedic Hospitals, 1 Unani Hospital, 6 Ayurvedic Prathmic Swasthya Kendras, 508 Ayurvedic Dispensaries, 19 Unani Dispensaries, 23 Homoeopathic Dispensaries. Ayurvedic Medical Education is being provided through Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra.

Under mainstreaming of AYUSH, 21 AYUSH Wings at District Hospitals (DHs) & 98 AYUSH OPD at CHCs, 109 AYUSH OPD at PHCs, have been set up during 2009-10 and 2010-11., Presently 73AMOs, 21 Yog Specialist, 22 Panchkarma Specialist, 4 UMOs, 116 HMOs. 208Paramedics and 80 other staff have been engaged to provide services in these institutes.

In District Charkhi Dadri there is one 10 bedded Ayurvedic Hospital is functioning at Imlota, Charkhi Dadri. In addition to this hospital 27 Govt. Ayurvedic Dispensaries are functioning in Charkhi Dadri District. As and when village Panchayat Mandoli will request for opening of GAD and provide free off cost 500 sq. yards land or constructed building to the AYUSH Department only then Department will consider the matter to open dispensary as per norms.
